BACKGROUND

The Office of Inspector General (OIG) of the Department of Commerce (the Department) seeks to improve management, strengthen integrity and accountability, investigate and deter fraud, and ensure the most efficient, effective, and economical use of resources. The missions and programs of each of the Department's twelve bureaus are diverse, and they have varying levels and types of risk inherent in their operations. The OIG is required by statute to semi-annually report on the top management challenges for the bureaus and across the Department.

The Federally Employee Engagement Survey (FEVS) results of recent years reflect challenges in engagement and morale leading the Department's OIG to take active and forward-looking steps to capitalize on opportunities to improve climate.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Department's OIG has contracted with the Academy to conduct an independent assessment of employee views and engagement, as well as identify recommended steps in the form of an action plan to improve working climate. The project will use the 2019 FEVS results as a starting point. Outreach to staff and leaderships will focus on identifying opportunities to strengthen the agency's employee performance management and engagement, as per the President's Management Agenda.

The assessment will be conducted via a multipronged approach including; analysis of FEVS results, a survey across office staff to measure OIG's organization and work environment, interviews with staff across departments within OIG, and focus groups of different sets of OIG staff. At the end of the assessment the Academy will facilitate the development of an action plan with OIG leaders. The Academy will conduct the work over a period of eight months under the guidance of an Expert Advisory Group (EAG) of Academy Fellows.
