To Host Panels on First Anniversary of President's Management Agenda Event Will Feature Senior Administration Officials, Release of NAPA Book

WASHINGTON, DC – The National Academy of Public Administration will host an event on the first anniversary of the President's Management Agenda (PMA), featuring panel discussions of PMA with senior Administration officials and the release of a new Academy book, *Perspectives on the President's Management Agenda*.

The first panel will include **Margaret Weichert**, Deputy Director for Management at the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and Acting Director of the U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM); **Emily Murphy**, Administrator of the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA); and **Suzette Kent**, Federal Chief Information Officer at OMB.
